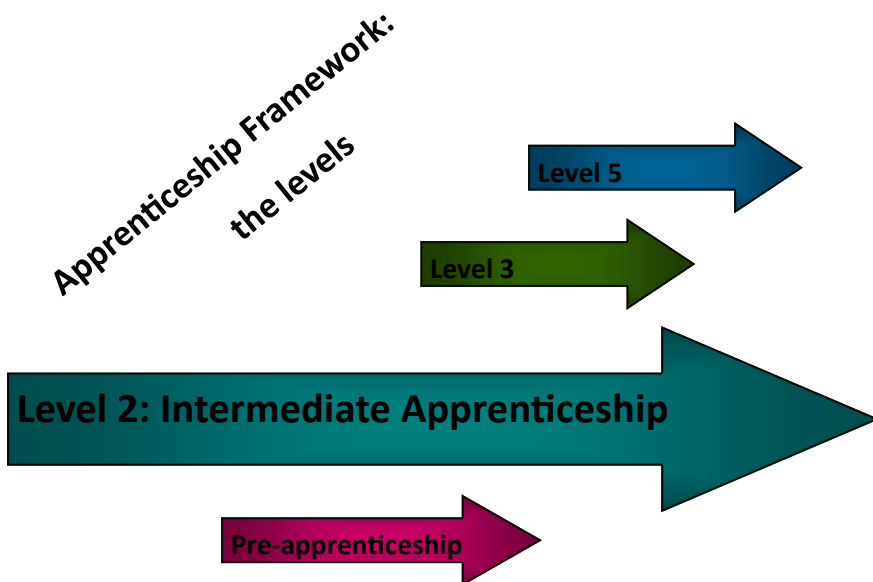


# Intermediate Apprenticeship: Level 2

### Why should I do a Level 2 Intermediate Apprenticeship in Adult Social Care?

A level 2 Intermediate Apprenticeship is the start of a tailored career route in the health and social care sector. The broad spectrum of skills still allows you to select an area within health and social care that appeals to you. In this case Occupational Therapy—you may start to show an interest in counselling, and supported living.

### Description

Apprentices can follow either health or social care specific pathways. Apprentices can further specialise by choosing one of three different pathways (generic, dementia or learning disability) through the competence part of the framework, the Diploma in Health and Social Care.

## Alternatives to Intermediate Apprenticeships

At this point you would benefit from tailoring your qualifications within health and social care in order to develop a career in Occupational Therapy for example. However there are also other access alternatives that you may prefer.
