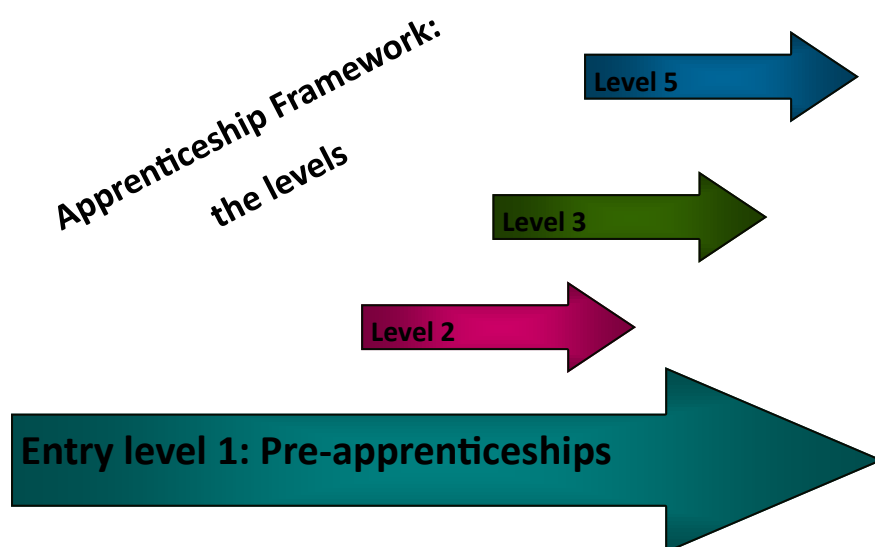


Pre-apprenticeships: Entry Level 1

Why should I do a Pre-apprenticeship?

If you are not sure what job you want to train for, need help with maths and English or need to build your confidence.

Description

A Pre-apprenticeship traineeship will help you develop skills, confidence and independence in preparation for an apprenticeship, work or further education and training.

You can also take on a work experience placement, or alternatively volunteer with the health and social care sector.

Alternatives to pre-apprenticeships

GCSEs | Work Experience | Volunteering | Paid work within health and social care

At this point you may want to explore industries, and you are not confined to health and social care. Pre-apprenticeships are often completed alongside, or after GCSE stage. They are often for those that have very few or no GCSEs as a way of building confidence, however English and Maths at GCSE level will be an essential qualification in reaching higher professional roles in health and social care further down the line.
